



Printable Learning Ideas

These printable pages are great for helping toddlers and preschoolers recognize colors and shapes. Print the pages and then cut out the shapes. Ask your child to match the shapes. You can also have your child sort the shapes by color. (Can you put all of the yellow shapes in a pile?)

Advanced: Play "I Spy" with the colors and shapes. You can adapt this to whatever level your child is at.

For example:

I spy with my little eye a shape that is blue (circle and hexagon)

I spy with my little eye a shape that has no sides (a circle)

I spy with my little eye a shape that has three sides (a triangle)

Other idea:

Paste the shape onto cardboard, index card or other heavy paper. Use hole puncher to punch a hole near the top of the shape. Use ribbon or other string to make a shape necklace. Allow your child to wear the shape of the day :)
